*Rs 1,000 crore
contract signed
to set up wind
farms in state*

AHMEDABAD, JANUARY 29

INOX Wind Ltd, a subsidiary of Gujarat Fluorochemicals Ltd, bagged a Rs 1,000 crore contract from Tata Power Renewable Energy Ltd for setting up two wind farm projects in Gujarat (54 MW) and Rajasthan (118 MW).

Under the agreements signed between the two entities, Inox will supply, erect and commission 86 units of its 2 MW wind turbine generations in both states.

The project in Gujarat, located near Rojmal village of Bhavnagar district, is scheduled to be completed by June 2015, while that in Rajasthan (Dangri village, Jaisalmer district) will be completed in two stages by March 2016.
